

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
SAMPLE	KEY/SKU	QTY	CUT	CUT PIECES VIA WOF
A	Messy Threads 5788-09 White/Multi	1-1/4 YDS (3) 10-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (44) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips. (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips*.		
B	Messy Threads 5788-10 Red	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
C	Messy Threads 5788-33 Orange	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
D	Messy Threads 5788-44 Lime	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
E	Messy Threads 5788-84 Turquoise	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
F	Messy Threads 5788-99 Black/Multi	1-3/8 YDS (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (44) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. (46) 2-1/2" squares. (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips*.		
G	Measure Twice 5789-09 White/Multi	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
H	Measure Twice 5789-99 Black/Multi	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
I	Button Geo 5790-12 Black/White	3/4 YD (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips*. (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips; BINDING.		
J	Button Geo 5790-22 Pink	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
K	Button Geo 5790-33 Yellow	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
L	Button Geo 5790-84 Turquoise	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
M	Spools 5791-99 Black	1/4 YD FQ (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		
N	Pins & Needles 5792-99 Black	1/3 YD (2) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.		

*SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN SEE BORDER ASSEMBLY | WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC



BLOCK ASSEMBLY


1. AF UNITS: Take (1) **F** 2-1/2" square and fold diagonally and press with iron or draw diagonal line on wrong side. Following diagram, place **F** square right sides together in corner of (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip, sew on diagonal line **NOTE DIRECTION OF STITCH**. Press open. Trim 1/4" excess fabric on reverse side. Repeat step to make 22 **AF1 UNITS** and 22 **AF2 UNITS**.



2. REFER TO BLOCK DIAGRAMS BELOW: Using **B-N** 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, **F** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips, **AF1** and **AF2** units, sew pieces to make Block Ones and Twos, **NOTE PROPER DIRECTION OF AF UNITS**.



ROW ASSEMBLY 3. Quilt top consists of 4 vertical rows. Refer to *Quilt Diagram* for proper placement of blocks. Then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so forth.



BORDER ASSEMBLY *Measure quilt top length and width to ensure **A**, **F** and **I** border cutting sizes, below are our measurements.*

4. I BORDER: Sew (1) **I** 1-1/2" x (60-1/2") strip to each side of quilt top. Then sew (1) **I** 1-1/2" x (46-1/2") strip to top and to bottom of quilt top.

5. F BORDER: Sew (1) **F** 2-1/2" x (62-1/2") strip to left side of quilt top. Then sew (1) **F** 2-1/2" x (48-1/2") strip to bottom of quilt top.

6. AF BORDER: Similar to **AF** unit corner assembly, make **AF1** border using (1) **A** 2-1/2" x (64-1/2) strip and (1) **F** 2-1/2" square. Sew **AF1** border to right side of quilt top, **NOTE PROPER DIRECTION OF F CORNER**. Make **AF2** border using **A** 2-1/2" x (50-1/2") strip. Sew **AF2** border to top of quilt top.

NOTE PROPER DIRECTION OF F CORNER.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When done quilting, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
