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


## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- **1.** Sew a **C** rectangle to the left side of all poinsettia window rectangles. Make 7 **C-I**, 4 **C-H**, 6 **C-G**, and 8 **C-F** units. See left diagram below.
- 2. Next sew a D strip to the top of all 25 Poinsettia-C units.
- **3.** Sew **A** strip to the left side of 20 **Poinsettia** units. Make 7 **F,** 5 **G**, 3 **H** and 5 **I**. You will have 5 blocks left, 2 **I**, 1 **F**, 1 **G** and 1 **H**.



**ROW ASSEMBLY** Follow photo for color placement of blocks.


**1.** Sew 5 rows of 5 blocks. Begin each row with one of the 5 blocks without the **A** strip, as ashown in diagram below. Set rows aside.



**2.** Make horizontal sashing by sewing 5 A strips together end to end with 4 B = 1-1/2" squares between each strip. Make 4 strips.




**3.** Add sashing to bottom of rows 1-4, as shown in diagram below. Then sew row1 to 2 and so forth. See quilt diagram below.



## **BORDER ASSEMBLY**

**Inner Border:** Sew **A** strips together at ends. Subcut (2) 54-1/2" long strips, sew to sides of quilt top. Subcut remaining **A** strip to (2) 55-1/2" long strips, sew to top and bottom of quilt top.

**OUTER BORDER:** Sew **E** strips together at ends. Subcut (2) 55-1/2" long strips, sew to sides of quilt top. Subcut remaining **E** strip to (2) 61-1/2" long strips, sew to top and bottom of quilt. top. See quilt diagram below.



## FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin with safety pins. Machine quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind in the usual manner.

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
