Please read all instructions before beginning.

Pre-washing recommended for hand dyes only. Prewashing NOT recommended for other fabrics.

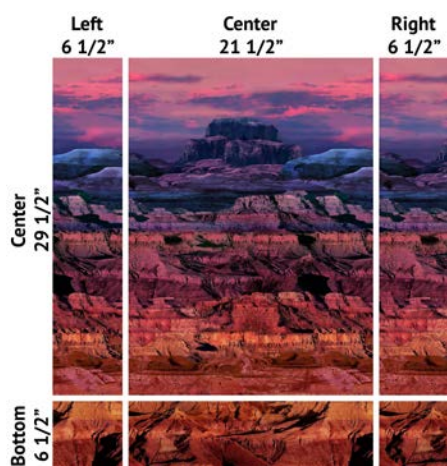
Yardages and Cutting

WOF is 42" width of fabric from selvedge edge to selvedge edge.

Remove as little fabric as possible when trimming selvages and squaring strip ends.

1 1/4 yards scenic print

- Carefully remove selvedge edges and square the long edges. Trim to 34 1/2" wide x 42 1/2" tall.
Note: The print in each piece may vary from the cover quilt based on the yardage cut purchased.
- Cut (1) 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" strip from the left edge and (1) 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" strip from the right edge. Cut a 6 1/2" square from the top and bottom of each strip (setting the tops aside), leaving a 29 1/2" strip in the center. Label these pieces left center, left bottom and right center, right bottom.
- The remaining section should be 21 1/2" x 42 1/2". Cut a 6 1/2" x 21 1/2" rectangle from the top and bottom (setting the top aside), leaving a 21 1/2" x 29 1/2" rectangle in the center. Label these pieces center and center bottom.



1/2 yard cloud print

- 2 strips 6 1/2" x WOF. cut into (1) 6 1/2" x 21 1/2" strip and (2) 6 1/2" squares for the top row.

1 1/2 yards sky stripe print

- 8 strips 6" x WOF for border. **1 yard canyon rock print**
- 6 strips 1" x WOF for inner border.
- 7 strips 2 1/4" x WOF for binding.

1/2 yard lavender hand dye

- 4 strips 2" x WOF; cut into (4) 2" x 24 1/2" and (8) 2" x 8" strips.
- 3 strips 2" x WOF for outer border frame. Sew these short ends together to make one long strip, and cut (2) strips 2" x 59 1/2"

3/4 yard purple hand dye

- 5 strips 2" x WOF; cut into (4) 2" x 29 1/2" and (8) 2" x 6 1/2" strips and (20) 2" squares.
- 4 strips 2" x WOF for outer border frame. Sew these short ends together to make one long strip and cut (2) strips 2" x 64 1/2".

1 1/4 yards black solid

- 5 strips 1 1/2" x WOF; cut into 2 each 41 1/2" and 32 1/2" strips and (4) 1 1/2" x 8" strips.
- 5 strips 2" x WOF for outer border.
- 7 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for outer border.

Backing

5 yards of 42" backing fabric

- 2 strips 86" x WOF

OR

2 1/4 yards wide backing fabric

- 1 piece 78" x 86"

Batting

- 1 piece 78" x 86"

Completing the Window Unit

Use a 1/4" seam allowance for all stitching. Press seams as directed.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each purple 2" square (20 total).
2. Place a marked square on 1 end of a 2" x 8" lavender strip as shown. Sew on the line. Trim seam allowance 1/4" out from the stitching. Press the purple triangle open to complete 1 short frame strip. Repeat to make 4 short

frame strips. Repeat to make 4 reverse short frame strips, placing the marked square on the opposite end of the strips with diagonal line as shown.

3. Repeat on both ends of the 2" x 24 1/2" lavender strips to make 4 long frame strips, positioning the diagonal lines as shown.

4. Repeat on both ends of the 2" x 59 1/2" lavender strips to make 2 outer border frame strips, positioning the diagonal lines as shown. Set aside for Step 7 in the next section.

5. Sew a 2" x 6 1/2" purple strip to the left edge of the left top cloud and left bottom scenic 6 1/2" squares. Press seams toward the squares. Add a short frame strip to the top of the top unit and a reverse short frame strip to the bottom of the bottom unit to make the 8" square Left Top and Bottom Window units. Press seams toward strips.



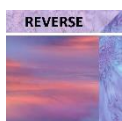
Left Top Window Unit



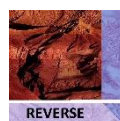
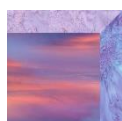
Left Bottom Window Unit



6. Repeat step 4 with the Right top cloud and right bottom scenic squares to make Right Top and Bottom Window units, placing purple strips and short frame and reverse short frame strips as shown.



Right Top Window Unit



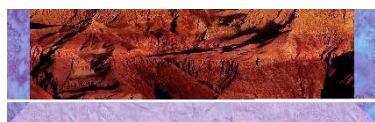
Right Bottom Window Unit



7. Stitch 2" x 6 1/2" purple strips to each short side of the 6 1/2" x 21 1/2" Center top cloud and bottom scenic rectangles. Press seams toward the rectangles. Add a long frame strip to the top of the top unit and to the bottom of the bottom unit to make the 8" x 24 1/2" Center Top and Bottom Window units. Press seams toward the frame strips.

8. Referring to the diagrams on the next page, sew 2" x 29 1/2" purple strips to 1 long side of the Left and Right center 6 1/2" x 29 1/2" scenic rectangles. Press seams toward the rectangles. Add a short frame strip to 1 end and a reverse short frame strip to the opposite end to complete the 8" x 32 1/2" Center Left and Right Window units. Press seams toward the frame strips.

9. Sew a 2" x 29 1/2" purple strip to the long sides of the 21 1/2" x 29 1/2" Center scenic rectangle. Press seams toward the rectangle. Add a long frame strip to the top and bottom to complete the 24 1/2" x 32 1/2" Center Window unit. Press seams toward the frame strips.



Completing the Quilt

1. Stitch the Center Left, Center and Center Right Window units together with (2) 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" black strips to make the 32 1/2" x 41 1/2" center row. Press seams toward the black strips.
2. Sew a 1 1/2" x 41 1/2" black strip to the long edges of the center row. Press seams toward the strips.
3. Stitch the Top Left, Center and Right Window units together with (2) 1 1/2" x 8" black strips to make the 8" x 41 1/2" top row. Press seams toward the black strips. Repeat with the Bottom Right, Center and Right Window units to make the bottom row.
4. Sew the rows to the top and bottom of the center row to complete the 41 1/2" x 49 1/2" quilt center. Press seams toward the black strips.
5. Stitch the 2" x WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) each 49 1/2" and 45 1/2" strips. Mark each pair of strips. Sew the 49 1/2" strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the 45 1/2" strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
6. Join the 1" canyon rock print strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press seams in one direction. Cut into (2) each 45 1/2" and 52 1/2" strips. Mark each pair of strips. Sew the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the center of the quilt.
7. Sew (2) 6" x WOF sky stripe strips orange ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Repeat to make (4) strips, each with the orange ends toward the center. Cut into (2) each 61" and 69" strips. Center and stitch the longer strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center, beginning, ending, and securing 1/4" from the corners of the quilt center. Repeat with remaining strips on the top and bottom. Miter corners using your favorite method, making sure all corners lie flat. Trim mitered corners to 1/4" and press. Press seams toward the strips.
8. Stitch the 2" x 64 1/2" purple hand dye strips to the sides of the quilt center, and the 2" x 59 1/2" outer border frame unit strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center, paying attention to the diagonal lines. Press seams toward the strips.
9. Stitch the 2 1/2" x WOF black strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to one side. Cut into (2) each 67 1/2" and 63 1/2" strips. Mark each pair of strips. Sew the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Press seams toward the strips.
10. If using 42" backing fabric, remove the selvedge edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 83" x 91" backing piece.

11. Layer the quilt top with the backing and batting pieces. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.

12. Join the 2 1/4" canyon rock print binding strips on the short ends with diagonal seams to make a long strip. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press seams in one direction. Press the strip in half along the length with wrong sides together. Bind the quilt edges using your favorite method to complete the quilt.
