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## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide unwashed fabric. Prewashing fabric may require additional yardage.

FQ = Fat Quarter, a fat quarter measures 18" x 22"

½ yd. Med. Blue Tonal (Y0767-29)  
 1 yd. Dk. Blue Tonal (Y0767-30)(incl. binding)  
 1 FQ Lt. Blue Tonal (Y0767-33)  
 1 FQ White w/ Blue Flowers (Y0768-1)  
 1 FQ Dk. Blue/Blue Flowers (Y0768-3)  
 1 FQ Lt. Blue w/White Flowers (Y0768-33)  
 1 FQ Dk. Blue Swirl (Y0769-3)  
 1 FQ Lt. Blue Swirl (Y0769-29)  
 1 FQ Med. Blue Swirl (Y0769-30)  
 1 FQ Med. Blue Vine (Y0770-29)  
 1 FQ Dk. Blue Vine (Y0770-30)  
 1 FQ Lt. Blue Vine (Y0770-33)  
 1 FQ Dk. Blue Lg. Flower (Y0771-3)  
 1 FQ Lt. Blue Lg. Flower (Y0771-33)  
 4 yd Backing of your choice

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric  
 LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Med. Blue Tonal cut:

2 - 15½" squares (M)

### From the Dk. Blue Tonal cut:

7 - 2½" x WOF (binding)

2 - 15½" squares (D)

### From the Lt. Blue Tonal cut:

1 - 15½" square (L)

### From White w/ Blue Flowers cut:

1 - 15½" square (L)

### From Dk. Blue w/ Blue Flowers cut:

1 - 15½" square (D)

### From Lt. Blue w/ White Flowers cut:

1 - 15½" square (L)

### From the Dk. Blue Swirl cut:

1 - 15½" square (D)

### From the Lt. Blue Swirl cut:

1 - 15½" square (M)

### From the Med. Blue Swirl cut:

1 - 15½" square (M)

### From the Med. Blue Vine cut:

1 - 15½" square (M)

### From the Dk. Blue Vine cut:

1 - 15½" square (M)

### From the Lt. Blue Vine cut:

1 - 15½" square (M)

### From the Dk. Blue Lg. Flower cut:

1 - 15½" square (D)

### From the Lt. Blue Lg. Flower cut:

1 - 15½" square (M)

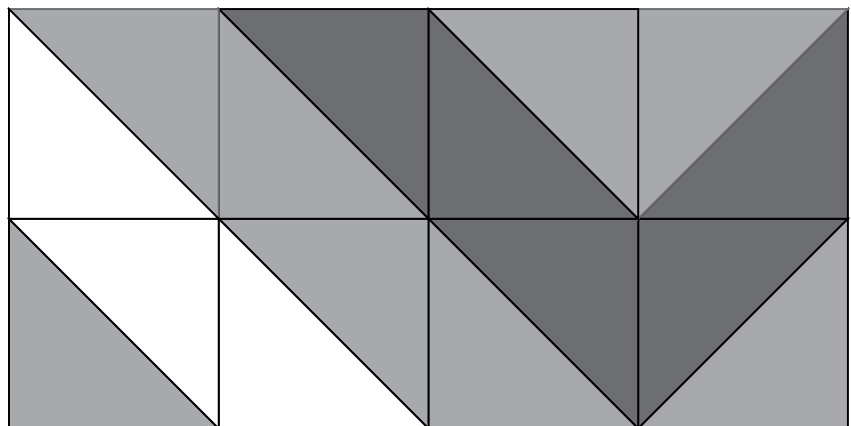
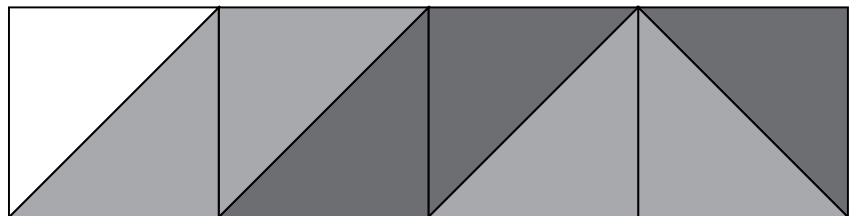
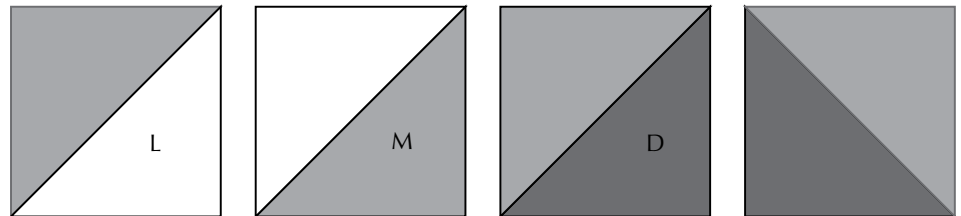

### Half-Square Triangle Block - Finished Size: 15" x 15"

1. Divide the 15½" squares into three piles, light (L), medium (M) and dark (D) referring to the letter in the cutting instructions. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all of the medium squares.
2. Place a medium square on top of a light square, right sides together and sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut the block diagonally on the drawn line and press each half open. Repeat two more times for a total of six light/medium half triangle squares.
3. Repeat step 2 using the medium and dark squares. Make a total of ten medium/dark half triangle squares.

### Putting It Together

1. Referring to the color photo and diagram below, layout the half-triangle squares completed above rotating as necessary. Sew the blocks into rows pressing after each. Sew the rows together.
2. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.
