Directions

Step One:

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CUT: from CX3979_Coral 16 - 4" x 4" squares (fussy cut the designs)
from CX3982_Aqua, Orange, Coral and Tan 5 - 2" strips x width of
fabric (from each of the 4 colors)
from CX3981_Coral 4 - 2 " x 8"

2 - 2" x 15 1/2"

2 - 2" x 33 1/2"

2 - 6" x 33 1/2"

2 - 6" x 42 1/2" (CUT FIRST - LENGTHWISE)
from CX3980_Coral 5 - 2" x wof For French Fold Binding
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Step Two:

Sew 16 log cabin blocks following Diagram One. Each block will start with the $4'' \times 4''$ fussy cut square in the corner (A) then build two sides of a color - 4'' (B) and 5 1/2'' (C), followed by 5 1/2'' (D) and 7'' (E), and then 7'' (F) and

8 1/2" (G). Cut from the 4 colors of 2" strips as you construct the blocks. You can do each block the same or mix them up as shown in the quilt photo. (1/4" seam allowance throughout) Press toward the outside.

Step Three:

The strips cut from the dot fabric will be sashing. Follow Diagram Two for placement.

Step Four:

Layout the quilt top as shown in the diagram. Sew it row by row across and then sew all rows together.

Step Five:

6" strips will be the outer border of the quilt. Sew top and bottom first, and then sides.

Step Six:

Piece backing as desired. Layer, quilt and bind!
