#### QUILT CENTER

#### Constructing Leaf Blocks (using chocolate focal block as example)

1. HST units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (3 7/8" x 3 7/8") A square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 (3 7/8" x3 7/8") K square. Sew 1/4" away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield 2 HST units. Open and press.



Sq to 3 1/2"

Repeat to make a total of 4 HST units.

2. Stem unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (3"  $\times$  3") A square. Place square, right sides together at a corner of 1 (3 1/2"  $\times$  3 1/2") K square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white tonal corner triangle. Repeat with another (3"  $\times$  3") A square at the opposite corner of the same (3 1/2"  $\times$  3 1/2") K square to complete a stem unit.



3. Arrange and sew 2 HST units and 1 (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") A square to make Row 1.



Arrange and sew 2 (3  $1/2" \times 3 1/2"$ ) K squares and 1 HST unit to make Row 2.



Arrange and sew 1 stem unit, 1 (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") K square and 1 HST unit to make Row 3.





Sew rows to complete 1 block.



Sq to 9 1/2"

4. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways:

4 blocks: P 3 blocks: J, K

2 blocks: L, M, N, O

#### Constructing Chain Blocks (using toast foliage block as example)

1. 4-patch units. Sew 2 (2" x 42") strips together - 1 A and 1 C. Cut pieced strips at 2" intervals. Sew 2 units together to make a four patch unit, as shown.



Sq to 3 1/2"

Repeat to make 2 A/C and 2 A/B four patch units.

Sew 2 (2"  $\times$  42") strips together - 1 C and 1 B. Sew 1 unit, sq to 3 1/2". Cut pieced strips at 2" intervals. Sew 2 units together to make a four patch unit, as shown.



2. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") F squares to the opposite sides of C/B four patch unit to make a row.



Sew 1 A/B four patch unit and 1 A/C four patch unit to the opposite sides of 1 (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") F square to make a row. Repeat to make 2 rows.





Sew rows together to complete 1 block.



Sq to 9 1/2"


3. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways:

4 blocks: D, E 3 blocks: F


2 blocks: G, H, I

### **Quilt Center Assembly**

1. Arrange 5 pieced blocks and 4 (1 1/2" x 9 1/2") A sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.








2. Pieced sashing row. Arrange and sew together 5 (1  $1/2" \times 9 1/2"$ ) A sashing rectangles, 2 (1  $1/2" \times 1 1/2"$ ) B sashing squares and 2 (1  $1/2" \times 1 1/2"$ ) C sashing squares.

Repeat to make a total of 6 pieced sashing rows.

3. Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows together to complete quilt center, noting the orientation of the pieced sashing rows in quilt center diagram.





#### **Quilt Top Assembly - Quilt WITH Border**

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew 2 (3"  $\times$  69 1/2") A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3"  $\times$  54 1/2") A strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew 2 (1 3/4" x 74 1/2") O strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1 3/4" x 57") O strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 3. Outer border. Sew 2 (5  $1/2" \times 77"$ ) K strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (5  $1/2" \times 67"$ ) K strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly - Quilt WITHOUT Border**

1. Outer border. Sew 2 (4"  $\times$  69 1/2") A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (4"  $\times$  56 1/2") A strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### **Quilting Instructions:**

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
