






Piecing Instructions


- 1. The quilt is assembled using vertical rows to create a continuous wave effect with color and fabrics. Rows 1 and 13 are created by sewing rectangles cut from **Fabrics A-G** together using a ¼" seam. Rectangles will create a long vertical row. Use the following guide to create Rows 1 and 13. Diagrams and guide show exact color order. Before sewing, check that color order is correct, it is crucial for the quilt top effect. Use written directions for pressing instruction.
- 2. Row 1: Sew 4 ½" x 4" rectangles together in the following fabric order as shown below:



- **3.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, Row 1 should measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Label as "Row 1" for organization.
- **4.** Row 13: Sew 5" x 4" rectangles together in the following fabric order as shown below:




- **5.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, Row 13 should measure $5'' \times 70 \frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished. Label as "Row 13" for organization.
- **6.** Rows 2-12 and 14-24 are created using strip sets. Each strip set features a unique fabric order. Some rows (Such as Row 2 and 24) use the same order of fabrics, therefore (1) strip set will be sewn to create both Rows 2 and 24. Subcut rows of various widths will be cut from each strip set. Follow the guide for fabric orders, total strip set width, and widths to subcut individual rows. Rows will be labeled, follow diagrams for accurate subcutting and fabric placement.
- 7. Rows 2 & 24: Sew together 7 ¾" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:




- **8.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the first sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $70 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **9.** Subcut (1) 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 2 and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 24. Label as "Row 2" and "Row 24".







10. Rows 3 & 23: Sew together 5 ¾" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:




- **11.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **12.** Subcut (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 3 and (1) 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 23. Label as "Row 3" and "Row 23".




13. Rows 4 & 22: Sew together 5 ¼" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:



- **14.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the first sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **15.** Subcut (1) $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 4 and (1) 3" x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 22. Label as "Row 4" and "Row 22".




16. Rows 5 & 21: Sew together 4 ½" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:







- 17. Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **18.** Subcut (1) 2" x 70 ½" strip for Row 5 and (1) 2 ½" x 70 ½" strip for Row 21. Label as "Row 5" and "Row 21".




19. Rows 6 & 20: Sew together 3 ¾" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:




- **20.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the first sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $3 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **21.** Subcut (1) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 6 and (1) 2" x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 20. Label as "Row 6" and "Row 20".



22. Rows 7 & 19: Sew together 2" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:




- **23.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $2'' \times 70 \frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
- **24.** Subcut (1) 1" \times 70 ½" strip for Row 7 and (1) 1" \times 70 ½" strip for Row 19. Label as "Row 7" and "Row 19".







25. Rows 8 & 18: Sew together 3" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:



- **26.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the first sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $3'' \times 70 \frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
- **27.** Subcut (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 8 and (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 18. Label as "Row 8" and "Row 18".




28. Rows 9 & 17: Sew together 4 ¼" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:



- **29.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **30.** Subcut (1) $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 9 and (1) 2" x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 17. Label as "Row 9" and "Row 17".



31. Rows 10 & 16: Sew together 4 ¾" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:




32. Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the first sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $4 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.




33. Subcut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 10 and (1) $2 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 16. Label as "Row 10" and "Row 16".




34. Rows 11 & 15: Sew together 6" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:



- **35.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the last sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $6" \times 70 \frac{1}{2}"$ unfinished.
- **36.** Subcut (1) 3" x 70 ½" strip for Row 11 and (1) 3" x 70 ½" strip for Row 15. Label as "Row 11" and "Row 15".



37. Rows 12 & 14: Sew together 7" x 4" strips together in the following fabric order as shown below:




- **38.** Press seams toward **Fabric A**, the first sewn rectangle. When complete, the strip set should measure $7'' \times 70 \frac{1}{2}''$ unfinished.
- **39.** Subcut (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 12 and (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for Row 14. Label as "Row 12" and "Row 14".





Quilt Center Assembly

- **40.** Lay out the quilt top according to the quilt layout diagram. Place rows in numerical order, starting with Row 1 on the left and ending with Row 24 on the right as shown. Seams have been pressed so that they can nestle as you sew. Use pins to keep seams aligned for a neat finish.
- **41.** Sew Rows 1-24 together to complete the quilt top center.





Border Assembly

- **42.** Create Border 1 by sewing (7) **Fabric A** 2 ½" x WOF strips together end to end using a diagonal seam.
- **43.** From the long **Fabric A** strip trim (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for the side borders. Trim (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 56" for the top/bottom borders to complete Border 1 assembly.
- **44.** Create Border 2 by sewing (7) **Fabric E** 1 ½" x WOF strips together end to end using a diagonal seam.
- **45.** From the long **Fabric E** strip trim (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for the side borders. Trim (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58" for the top/bottom borders to complete Border 2 assembly.
- **46.** Create Border 3 by sewing (2) **Fabric D** $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips together end to end using a diagonal seam. Repeat (4) times to create (4) long strips.
- **47.** From the **Fabric D** strips, trim (2) to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $76 \frac{1}{2}$ " for the side borders. Trim (2) strips to $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 66" for the top/bottom borders to complete Border 3 assembly.
- **48.** Attach borders in numerical order. When attaching borders, sew side borders on first followed by the top/bottom borders. Press all seams toward the last sewn border.

Finishing

- **49.** With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.
- 50. Baste and quilt as desired.
- **51.** Attach **Fabric E** binding to complete quilt.
