



# Spring Splendor Mug Mats

By Colleen Tauke | Finished Size: 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"



## **Yardage**

(Set of 4 mug mats) 1 F8th each of 4 petal fabrics

1/8 yd leaf fabric

1/4 yd white

1/4 yd binding

1/4 yd backing

# **Supplies**

Rotary Cutter

**Cutting Mat** 

8" 14" and 6-1/2" square or similar

Fabric marking pen/pencil

1/4" seam marker (optional but useful)

Scissors

Pins

Batting 8" x 36"

#### Notes

WOF = width of fabric

RST = right sides together

HST = half square triangle

# Cutting

# Petal Fabric (repeat this cutting for each color)

- (1) 2-1/2" square
- (1) 3" square
- (1) 1-1/2" square

#### Leaf Fabric

(4) 3" square

#### White

- (12) 2-1/2 " squares
- (8) 3" squares
- (4) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles
- (4) 1-1/2" square

## Binding


(3) 2-1/4" strips x WOF






#### Construction

Flower corner unit - collect the (4) white 1-1/2" squares, (4) white 1-1/2"  $\times$  2-1/2" rectangles and (4) 1-1/2" petal squares. Place one white and one petal 1-1/2" square RST and join with a 1/4" seam. Press seam toward the darker fabric. Next, join one white rectangle to one side of the previously created unit. Note the diagram for proper alignment. Press seam toward the rectangle. Make (4) flower corner units.



Collect the (1) 3" petal square, (1) 3" leaf square and (2) 3" white squares. Mark the wrong side of the white squares with a diagonal line as shown below. Match each white square RST with a petal color and a leaf color square. Stitch 1/4" on each side, of the marked lines as shown below by the broken line. Cut the square apart, as shown by the red line. Repeat this process for each pair of squares. Repeat with all petal and leaf 3" squares.




Press all seam allowances toward the darker fabric. This will yield:

- (2) HST in petal color/white = petal units **and**
- (2) HST in leaf color/white = leaf units.




# Trim all HST to 2-1/2"

Arrange the flower corner unit, leaf units, petal units and remaining (3) 2-1/2" white squares and the (1) 2-1/2" petal square using the block diagram that follows. Join units into rows and then join rows to complete the block. The block will measure 6-1/2" square. Repeat this construction process with each petal color to Make (4) Splendid Spring blocks.







Layer each mug mat block with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Apply binding. Your Spring Splendor mug mats are complete.
