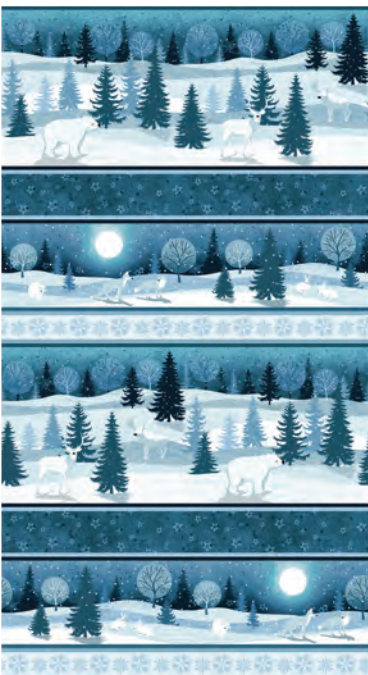

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

From the Patchwork (A), cut:

- Fussy cut (5) patches approximately 5 ½" square.

From the Dk. Blue Stars (B), cut:

- (2) 7 ½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips and (10) 1 ½" x 5 ½" strips.
- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (40) 3 ½" squares.
- (1) 4 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 4 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) Template One units.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) Template Two units.

From the Lt. Blue Snowflakes (C), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (20) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 4 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (16) 4 ⅞" squares.
- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (8) 6 ½" squares.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) Template Three units.

From the Lt. Blue Stars (D), cut:

- (1) 4 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 4 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 6 ½" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) Template One units.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) Template Two units.

From the Dk. Blue Deer (E), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (3) 4 ½" squares.

From the Blue Bears (F), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (3) 4 ½" squares.

From the Stripe (G), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 48 ½" strips from the length of fabric (LOF).

From the Dk. Blue Snowflakes (H), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Dark Blue Paisley (I), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (2) 5 ½" x 63 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (2) 5 ½" x 61 ½" strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) Template One units.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) Template Two units.

From the Blue Owl Dots (J), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (2) 4 ½" squares.

From the Dk. Blue Paisley (Backing), cut:

- (2) 69" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 81" backing.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.

2. Place another 3 ½" Fabric B square on the right side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to complete (1) B/C/B unit.

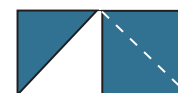

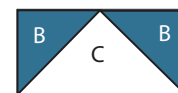

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (20) B/C/B units total.

4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 5 ½" Fabric A patch. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A patch. Trim the block to measure 6 ½" square to make (1) Block One center. Repeat to make (5) Block One centers total.

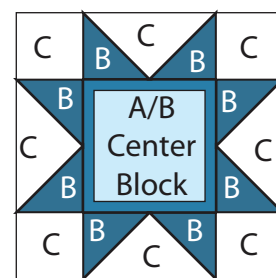

5. Sew (1) B/C/B unit to each side of (1) Block One center. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric C square to each end of (1) B/C/B unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the 3 ½" Fabric C square to complete (1) Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.

6. Place (1) 4 ⅞" Fabric B square on top of (1) 4 ⅞" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 6). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7) to make two B/C units (Fig. 8). Trim B/C units to measure 4 ½" square. Repeat to make (16) B/C units total.

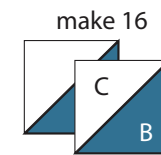

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7. Repeat Step 6 using (8) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D squares and (8) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C squares to make (16) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " D/C units total.

8. Sew (1) Fabric D-Template One unit, (1) Fabric D-Template Two unit and (1) Fabric C-Template Three unit together to make (1) D/C/D unit (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (12) D/C/D units total.

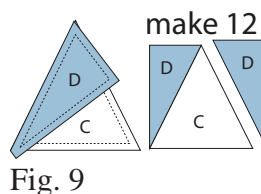

9. Sew (1) Fabric B-Template One strip and (1) Fabric B-Template Two strip and (1) Fabric C-Template Three strip together to make (1) B/C/B unit. Repeat to make (12) B/C/B units total.

10. Sew (1) Fabric I-Template One strip, (1) Fabric I-Template Two strip and (1) Fabric C-Template Three strip together to make one I/C/I unit. Repeat to make (8) I/C/I units total.

11. Follow Figure 10 and sew (4) B/C units, (4) D/C/D units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square together to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make a second Block Two.

12. Follow Figure 11 and sew (4) D/C units, (4) B/C/B units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square together to make (1) Block Three. Repeat to make a second Block Three.

13. Follow Figure 12 and sew (4) B/C units, (4) I/C/I units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square together to make one Block Four.

14. Follow Figure 13 and sew (4) D/C units, (4) D/C/D units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square together to make (1) Block Five.

15. Follow Figure 14 and sew (4) B/C units, (4) B/C/B units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square together to make (1) Block Six.

16. Follow Figure 15 and sew (4) D/C units, (4) I/C/I units and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square together to make (1) Block Seven.

17. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strips and (8) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares to make (4) C/D/C units.

18. Sew (1) C/D/C unit to each side of one Block One square. Sew (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each end of (1) C/D/C unit to make the top border. Repeat to the bottom border. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the Block One to complete the Center Block (Fig. 16).

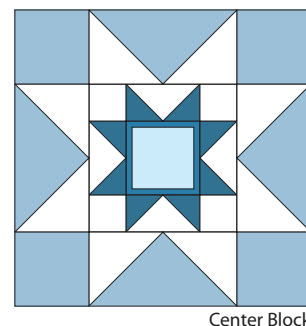

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the quilt photo while assembling.)

19. Refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew together the assorted blocks to make the quilt top.

20. Sew (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

21. Sew (1) 2" x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

22. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

23. Layer and quilt as desired.

24. Sew the (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

25. Bind as desired.

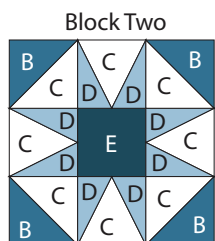

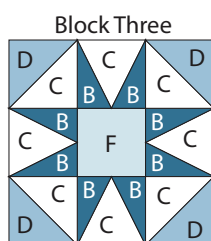

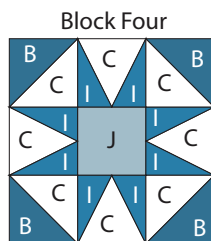

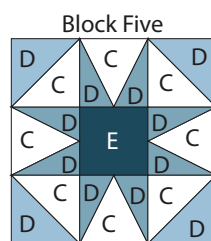

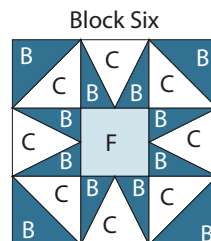

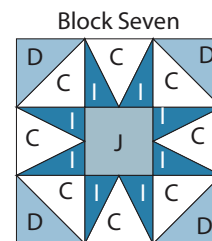
