Cutting for Basket Blocks and Borders

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof) unless indicated otherwise.

Black bark, cut:

- (2) 3" x wof strips; crosscut into (24) 3" squares
- (2) 2 ⁷/₈" x wof strips; crosscut into (27) 2 ⁷/₈" squares and then cut each square in half diagonally to yield (54) triangles
- (6) 2 ¹/₄" x wof binding strips
- (5) 1 ¹/₂" x wof inner-border strips

Green/teal dots, cut:

- (8) 3" squares 3" x 3"
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" squares

Red/orange dots, cut:

- (8) 3" squares
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" squares

Red/teal dots, cut:

- (8) 3" squares
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" squares

Taupe linen, cut:

- (5) 9" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (10) triangles (1 is extra)
- (5) 5" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (10) triangles (1 is extra)
- (18) 2 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" rectangles

Burgundy medium floral, cut:

- (6) 8" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (12) triangles

Green tossed flowers, cut:

- (4) 8" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (8) triangles

Cream swirl, cut:

- (4) 8" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (8) triangles

Gold bark, cut:

- (4) 8" squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (8) triangles

Burgundy main floral, cut:

- (4) 6 ¹/₂" x *lengthwise grain* outer-border strips

Cutting for Appliques

See applique instructions below and use the patterns to cut the following pieces.

Burgundy main floral, cut:

- 1 heart

Blue medium floral, cut:

- 2 flowers for middle block, top row
- 1 large flower for right block, center row
- 2 butterfly wings

Green tossed flowers, cut:

- 3 leaves for left block, top row
- 2 strawberry caps for left block, center row
- leaf/stem for right block, bottom row

Red tossed flowers, cut:

- 1 outer flower for left block, top row
- 1 outer flower for right block, top row
- 1 strawberry for left block, center row
- 14 small berries for middle block and right block, center row *and* right block, bottom row
- 1 flower for right block, center row
- 1 bird
- 9 petals for left block, bottom row

Orange swirl, cut:

- 3 acorns for middle block, bottom row

Green bark, cut:

- 4 wreath rings
- 64 wreath leaves
- 1 acorn leaf for middle block, bottom row
- 1 stem for left block, top row
- 3 stems and 3 leaves for center block, top row
- 1 leaf and 1 leaf reversed for right block, top row
- 1 strawberry cap for left block, center row
- 1 leaf and 1 leaf reversed for center block, middle row
- 1 stem and 2 leaves for right block, middle row
- 2 leaves for left block, bottom row

Black bark, cut:

- 1 center flower dot for left block, top row
- 1 center flower dot for right block, top row
- 1 center flower dot for left block, bottom row
- 1 butterfly body

Pink bark, cut:

- 1 bird wing
- 2 strawberries for left block, center row
- 3 small dots for right block, bottom row

Teal bark, cut:

- 2 ovals for middle block, top row
- 3 stars
- 1 flower bottom for right block, center row
- 1 large circle for left block, bottom row

Gold bark, cut:

- 1 oval for left block, top row
- 1 small flower for right block, top row

Brown linen, cut:

- 3 acorn caps for middle block, bottom row

Making the Basket Blocks

Refer to the photo for color placement guidance.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3" polka dot squares. Layer the marked squares right sides together with the 3" black bark squares, and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut the squares apart on the drawn line. Make five matching half-square-triangle (HST) units for each block. Trim the HST units to measure 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

2. To make the bottom unit for each basket, lay out five matching HST units, one matching 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " polka dot square, six 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " black bark triangles, and two taupe linen rectangles as shown. Sew the pieces together in rows and then sew the rows together. Join a 5" taupe linen triangle to the base of the unit.

3. To complete the basket unit, sew a 9" taupe triangle to the top of the unit.

Note: Several blocks have stems that need to be appliquéd before sewing this triangle to the base of the basket. Trim the basket unit to measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make nine units.

4. Sew 8" triangles to all four sides of each basket unit as shown in the photo to complete the block. Make nine blocks.

Appliqué

5. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each pattern onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape about an $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the drawn line.

6. Fuse each shape on the wrong side of the fabric as indicated in the cutting list. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.

7. Referring to the quilt photo, position and fuse the shapes to the basket blocks. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a satin or blanket stitch.

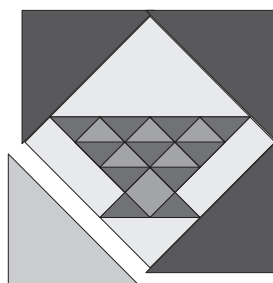
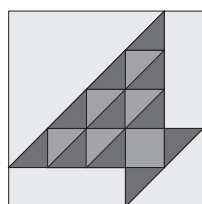
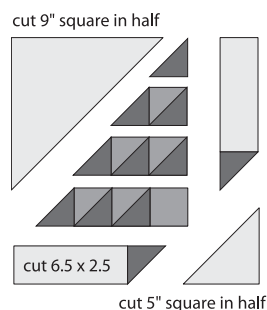
8. Sew the blocks together in three rows of three blocks each as shown in the photo. Then appliqué the wreath blocks and remaining shapes to the quilt top.

Finishing

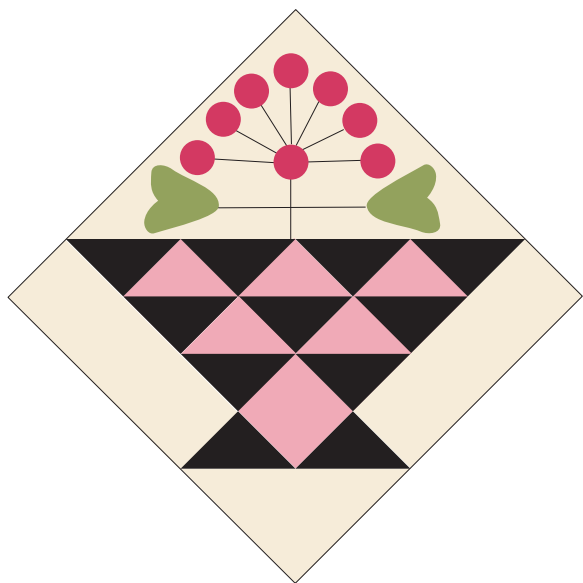
9. For the inner border, sew the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide black bark strips together end to end. Measure the width of the quilt through the center and cut two strips to this length. Sew the strips to the quilt top. Measure the length of the quilt, cut two strips to this length and sew them to the quilt top.

10. For the outer border, measure the width of the quilt through the center and trim two 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide main floral strips to this length. Sew the strips to the quilt top. Measure the length of the quilt, trim the two remaining strips to this length and sew them to the quilt top.

11. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

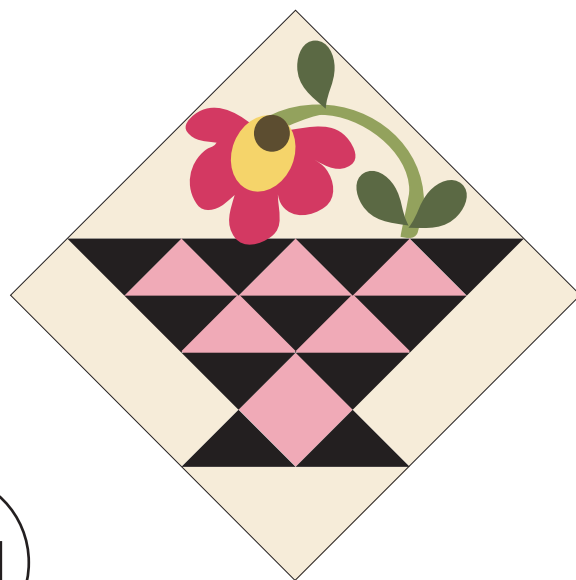


Basket Block Diagram

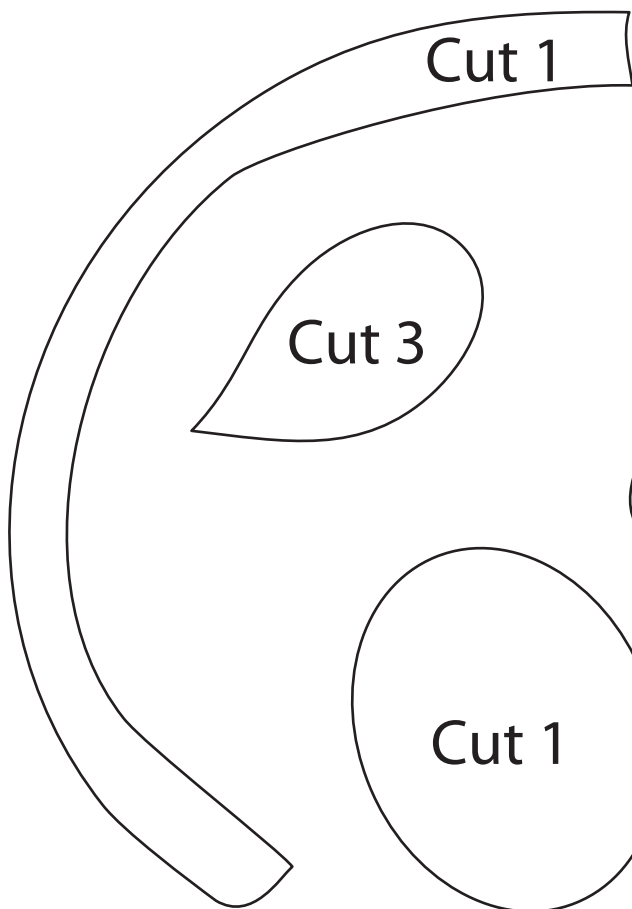
