KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		253Q-5 Blue	1/3	(2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (13) 3-1/2" squares.
B		257Q-3 Sea Green	1-1/4	(20) 1-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut one strip in (20) 1-7/8" squares. Leave (19) strips intact.
C		262Q-4 Dark Teal	7/8	(6) 3-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (52) 3-7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally (104 HST).
D		264Q-4 Blue	1-2/3	(12) 1-7/8" x WOF strips. <b>Border:</b> (6) 4-3/4" x WOF strips.
E		266Q-5 Teal	1	(3) 4" x WOF strips; subcut (26) 4" squares. Cut once diagonally (52 HST). <b>Bind:</b> (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
F		269Q-7 Gold	1/2	(4) 2-3/8" x WOF strips; subcut (52) 2-3/8" squares. Cut once diagonally (104 HST). (1) 1-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 1-7/8" squares.
G		100Q-1428 Cucumber	3-1/4	(2) 4-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (13) 4-1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally (52 QST). (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (52) 2" squares. (3) 4" x WOF strips; subcut (26) 4" squares. Cut once diagonally (52 HST). (3) 7-1/4" x WOF strips; subcut (13) 7-1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally (52 QST). (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (48) 4-1/2" x 3-1/8" rectangles. (11) 1-7/8" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 1-7/8" x 4-3/4" rectangles and (16) 1-7/8" squares. Leave (8) 1-7/8" strips intact. <b>Border:</b> (12) 1-7/8" x WOF strips.

## BLOCK 1

### CENTER BLOCK STAR

1. Create a flying geese unit by sewing (2) **F** 2-3/8" HST to both sides of (1) **G** 4-1/4" QST. Repeat to create (52) 2" 3-1/2" flying geese units.
2. Sew (2) **G** 2" squares to the sides of a flying geese unit and press seams towards **G**. Repeat to create (26) units.
3. Sew (2) flying geese units to the sides of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square and press seams towards **A**.
4. Then sew the units made in *Step 2* to the top and bottom of **A** to create the *Center Block Star* as shown in the diagram.



## Outer Block Units

5. Follow *Step 1* using (2) **C** 3-7/8" HST and (1) **G** 7-1/4" QST. Make (52) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" flying geese units.
6. Create (52) *HST Units* by sewing (1) **G** 4" HST and (1) **E** HST. Trim the HST to 3-1/2" square unfinished.
7. Sew *HST Units* to both ends of (1) flying geese unit. Press seams towards the *HST Unit*. Make (26) units.
8. Sew (2) flying geese units to the sides of a *Center Block Star* as shown and press seams towards the center.
9. Sew the units made in *Step 7* to the tops and bottoms finishing *Block 1*. Make (13) 12-1/2" squares.

## BLOCK 2

10. Create strip sets by sewing together 1-7/8" strips from **G**, **D** and **B** in the following order:


**Strip Set 1:** Create (5) strip sets combining **D + B + G**. Subcut (96) 1-7/8" units.

**Strip Set 2:** Create (3) strip sets combining **B + D + B**. Subcut (60) 1-7/8" units.


**Strip Set 3:** Create (2) strip sets combining **D + B + D**. Subcut (24) 1-7/8" units.

**Strip Set 4:** Create (3) strip sets combining **B + G + B**. Subcut (48) 1-7/8" units.

11. Using (4) **G** 3-1/8" x 4-1/2" rectangles, sew together *Block 2* using the diagram below. **D** should create an "X" through the middle of the block. Trim to measure 12-1/2" square. Repeat to create (12) blocks.

## ROW BLOCK ASSEMBLY

12. Refer to *Quilt Diagram* for proper layout of alternating *Blocks 1* and *Blocks 2* (five per row). Sew across together. See sample below.





## CORNER BLOCK (BORDER)

13. Sew together (4) **G**, **F** and (1) **B** 1-7/8" squares as shown in the below. Make (4) *9-patch Units*.
14. Sew (2) **B** 1-7/8" squares to the ends of (1) **G** 1-7/8" x 4-3/4" rectangle. Make (8) units.
15. Sew (2) **G** 1-7/8" x 4-3/4" rectangles to the sides of the *9-patch Units*. Repeat on all (4) *9-patch Units*.
16. Complete the block by sewing units made in *Step 13* to the tops and bottoms to make 7-1/2" square corner blocks.




9-patch Unit




## BORDER

17. Cut (4) **G** 1-7/8" WOF strips in half lengthwise to create (8) shorter strips. Sew a short **G** 1-7/8" strip to each of the (8) remaining **G** 1-7/8" WOF strips to create (8) long strips. Trim strips to 60-1/2".
18. Cut (2) **D** 4-3/4" WOF strips in half lengthwise to create (4) shorter strips. Sew a short **D** 4-3/4" strip to each of the (4) remaining **D** 4-3/4" WOF strips (using a straight 1/4" seam) to create (4) long strips. Trim strips to 60-1/2".
19. Sew **G** strips to both sides of (1) **D** strip. Make (4) border strips.
20. Sew a *Corner Block* onto both ends of (2) border strips. Press seams towards the borders.





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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

21. Sew quilt top rows together from top to bottom as the *Quilt Diagram*. Press seams in alternate directions to nestle seams.
22. Sew the borders *without* Corner Blocks to the side of the quilt top. Press seams to borders.
23. Complete quilt top by sewing the borders *with* Corner Blocks, top and bottom of quilt.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.  
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using (8) **E** 2-1/4" strips.
